

Things I need for your bankruptcy

A list of all your assets that are paid for. Don't list things that you could not sell or pawn for more than \$500. Such as cars, boats, and campers.

A list of all the things (assets) that you owe money on, such as car loans and furniture. Tell me which creditor goes with which assets.

A list of ALL your creditors. Don't leave anyone out. I need to know about all your debts. Even if you "don't want to bankrupt on them" and all your debts to relatives and friends.

Please put the creditor name, address and account number. Approximate balances are OK. The names and addresses are more important than the amount owed.

It will be a big help if you can put the lists in a Word or Excel file, Email it to cblack@bellsouth.net or bring a disk or USB thumb drive.

I need at least two months of your pay stubs. Bring them for you spouse, even if they are not filing with you. In some cases I need 7 months of pay stubs. If you have some stubs from 6 or 7 months ago, bring them.

I need the last tax return you filed.

If you have monthly home mortgage statements bring the latest ones.

If you have been served with any papers, bring them.

If you are getting letters from bill collectors or lawyers, bring them.

If IRS or Georgia Department of Revenue is sending you letters, bring them.

If you bank with Wells Fargo, change banks before you file for bankruptcy, they will freeze your account. If you are on a parent's account that banks with Wells Fargo, they will freeze that account too.
